General

Headphones/earbuds will be required for Fast-Bridge testing for 9th grade students and may be needed at times in other classes.

Students are expected to bring their chromebook to school fully charged each day.

Art

Digital Art Design: A digital camera is strongly suggested. **Digital Art Photography:** Flash drive, personal digital camera (probably an SLR) of 8 megapixel or larger with memory card).

AP Studio Art I & II 2-D Design: flash drive (1 GB min).

Business & Marketing

Students will need a folder or binder, notebook and writing utensil.

Computer Science

Exploring Computer Science, Cybersecurity, Web Development I and II: Students will need a folder or binder, notebook and writing utensil.

AP Computer Science A, Computer Programming, Game Design, AP Computer Science Principles: USB Flash drive, folder or binder, notebook and writing utensil. Data Structures: USB Flash drive, Graphing calculator (TI -83, TI-83 plus, TI-84, TI-84 plus or TI-84 plus C, folder or binder, notebook and writing utensil.

English

On a daily basis, students will need writing utensils and dedicated supplies for taking notes and organizing handouts.

Engineering & Technology

All Project Lead the Way students will need writing utensils, folder, notebook, flash drive headphones, and calculator.

Construction I, II & III: Writing utensils, folder, notebook, flash drive and calculator.

Graphic Production I, II: Writing utensils, folder, and headphones.

Graphic Production III: Writing utensils and folder.

Health Occupations

Certified Nursing Assistant WCTC: Lab and Clinical Days require cobalt blue scrub top and pants. You must purchase the scrubs at the WCTC bookstore. You must purchase a gait belt, a watch with a second hand and flexible watchband are also required for class and clinical as is white tennis shoes.

LOCKERS AND LOCKS

Concert Choir: Students must supply black dress shoes. Pencil and water bottle.

Concert Orchestra: Essential Technique 2000 (book 3), binder, instrument.

Jazz Ensemble: Instrument

Symphonic/Marching Band: Instrument, Uniform expectations are set by the band directors.

Treble Choir: Black dress shoes for performances. Pencil and water bottle.

Chamber Singers: Pocket folder and pencil. Black dress shoes for performances.

Chamber Orchestra: Essential Elements Advanced Technique (book 4), binder, instrument.

Science

Biology and Honors: Binder and folder/ composition books (1 per quarter), pens, pencils, colored pencils.
