- · All players must wear a batting helmet.
- Each participant gets eight (8) outs. Each ball hit that is not a Home Run is counted as an out.
 Any pitch that is swung upon and missed, fouled, or not hit over the fence is counted as an out.
- Balls that are batted over the fence in fair territory are considered Home Runs and will not be counted toward the total outs.
- Tie breaker: Each player gets 3 additional outs.
- Trophies will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place.


