Principal's Message

As many Poplar Creek families know, Act 20 is a piece of legislation that focuses on literacy instruction. It's goal is to have all students, kindergarten through 3rd grade, reading proficiently by the end of their third grade year. The law was enacted in 2023 and the requirements are being implemented for the 2024-2025 school year. SDNB has always prided itself on being at the forefront of learning about, preparing for, and implementing instructional strategies that first student learning and individual growth, regardless of gradelevel. SDNB has worked tirelessly to ensure instructional staff, support staff, students, and families had all the information needed to make whatever shifts deemed necessary (and due to our preparation, the shifts were not large).

The law's purpose is to provide guidance of evidence-based reading practices, evaluate early literacy skills, ensure all kindergarten through third grade and special education educators are equipped with the proper knowledge to teach reading, and document and enhance communication across stakeholders.

A universal reading screening assessment is administered to students three times per year. Students performing at or below the 25th percentile on this screener are then given an additional diagnostic assessment to determine the need for any further intervention. If further intervention is necessary, a Personal Reading Plan is created for the student which includes goals, interventions, and progress monitoring.

In the upcoming days, some families may receive a phone call from their student's grade-level teacher regarding the implementation of a Personal Reading Plan for their student. As part of that phone call, your student's teacher will provide families with details of their plan, how it will be implemented and monitored, and how data will be collected to measure their student's growth. If you have any questions about your student's Personal Reading Plan, or how Poplar Creek supports literacy growth in its students, please reach out to myself or Ms. Torosian.

A reminder about Parent-Teacher Conferences: Thursday, Oct. 24, are the final date when instructional staff will be in the building. Please check emails from, and communicate with, your child's teacher to see if they have any available time slots left for Oct. 24. The Parent-Teacher Conference "Window" closes Thursday, Oct. 31.
